

## Behavioral Health Services

Behavioral Health staff conduct assessments and make treatment recommendations according to medical necessity criteria. Based on the needs of each individual, staff may make referrals to other community organizations and/or authorize services at one of our clinics or our organizational provider sites. Medi-Cal recipients must have an assessment and be referred by BHD in order to receive services from one of our organizational providers.



## ADULT SYSTEM OF CARE

Adult System of Care provide services to adult individuals suffering from severe and persistent mental health problems. These services include crisis intervention, psychiatric assessments, individual and group therapy, medication service, and case management. Outreach to homeless mentally ill individuals and other underserved populations, housing assistance and intensive 'whatever it takes' case management services are also available through the Full-Service Partnership (FSP) Program.

## CHILDRENS SYSTEM OF CARE

Children's System of Care (CSOC) provides services to children with severe emotional and behavioral problems. Services include psychiatric evaluations, medication services, individual, group, and family therapy, crisis, case management, and FSP services. Staff work collaboratively with schools and other agencies throughout Siskiyou County to promote family unity and strengthen community support systems. Our Wraparound Program is a family centered, individualized, community based, strength focused, needs driven collaborative approach to mental health treatment. A team of professional Clinicians and Behavioral Health Specialists work together with Probation Officers, Children's Protective Services, and other community members to ensure the family reaches their goals. Wraparound services are provided through a contract with Northern Valley Catholic Social Services.





## CRISIS SERVICES

People who have a psychiatric emergency can get help 24 hours a day from the County of Siskiyou Behavioral Health Division Crisis Team. ## ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUGS PROGRAMS

### **Next Step Intensive Outpatient Treatment Program**

for Women is an intensive program that offers drug and alcohol treatment services and classes pertaining to addiction, recovery and improved daily living to pregnant and parenting women.

**Turn Around** is an intensive outpatient treatment program that offers drug and alcohol treatment services including assessment, individual and group treatment, residential treatment and ancillary services.

**The Outpatient Lifeworks Treatment program** is a flexible treatment program that offers 1 and a half hour treatment groups Monday through Friday. Clients may move between this less intensive treatment modality and an intensive program based upon treatment need.

**Prevention** services include information and referral, education and support services that are available to the community at large (including people in the earliest stages of experiencing alcohol and other drug problems) and for family members and significant others.
