## CURRENT SITUATION

### Situation Summary:

The fire is holding within current containment lines. Firefighters continue to mitigate hazards and patrol for new smokes as they construct and strengthen existing firelines. The steep terrain and dry heavy fuels challenge firefighters in their efforts to reach full containment.
