CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	<p>At 4:00 p.m. today, CAL FIRE Incident Management Team 5 assumed command of the Mill and Mountain Fires. Weather continues to be hot and dry with poor overnight relative humidity recoveries. A number of resources continued to arrive throughout the day, personnel engaged in structure defense and strengthening control lines. Damage Assessment imagery has been processed; 132 structures have been affected. Damage Inspection teams will begin ground truthing damaged and destroyed structures tomorrow.
