CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Today began a period of warming and drying weather that is expected to last through Tuesday over the Mill Fire area. Firefighters held and improved containment lines and provided structure defense throughout the fire area. The fire is not anticipated to spread. Today the damage assessment team began validating damaged or destroyed structures. The Siskiyou County Sheriff's Office lifted some Evacuation Orders and Warnings, allowing residents to return.
