Ensure all working bottles are labeled to avoid mishandling of hazardous materials. Correct asap.</p> <p>14) Observed numerous pieces of damaged equipment throughout the facility. Maintain equipment to be cleanable and serviceable at all times. Repair or replace within 90 days.</p> <p>14) Observed several finishes for shelving, countertops, and other that are bare wood. These surfaces are required to be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Seal, paint, or replace this wood within 90 days.</p> <p>17) Observed missing single use paper towels at multiple handwashing facilities. Ensure the handwashing stations are constantly equipped with hand soap, warm water, and single-use paper towel in a dispenser.</p> <p>20) Facility doesn't currently have a food manager certification. Obtain a new food manager certification with 60 days.</p> <p>29) Observed damaged to vinyl floorings throughout the facility. Maintain all floors to be smooth, durable in construction, easily cleanable, and nonabsorbent. Additionally, there are several areas where the baseboard molding is damaged or completely missing. Repair or correct within 90 days.</p> <p>30) Observed broken light shields and ceiling panels throughout the facility. Maintain these structures are fully serviceable and ensure food are protected from contaminants. Repair within 90 days.</p> <p>30) Observed numerous holes and damaged finishes on the walls throughout the various areas in the facility. Ensure walls are smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent.
