Flood Control District - Adopt Resolution approving a Memorandum of Understanding with the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection and associated Conservation Camp Project Request, for the Deadwood Conservation Camp to provide fuels management, fire reduction, and trail maintenance services on Flood District property, in an amount not to exceed \$9,985.36 for the term July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2027.

In response to Director Kobseff regarding the use of equipment to manage trees/brush around Lake Siskiyou, General Services Director Joy Hall advised of the ongoing use of a masticator to manage forest fuels at the Lake.

It was moved by Director Kobseff, seconded by Director Valenzuela and carried, following a roll call vote with Directors Kobseff, Valenzuela, Ogren and Criss voting YES and Director Haupt ABSENT to approve the Resolution, FLD 22-04 and MOU and authorize the CAO or designee to initiate future rate agreements as they pertain to the MOU.
